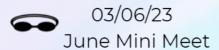

WHAT A MEET

Our annual Twilight Encouragement Meet held on Saturday 6th May was a great success, with approximately 130 swimmers in attendance.

Great racing from our 31 representatives, many of whom competed for the first time. Medallists and first-timers included:

- Athan, Abhi and Leia representing the club at a meet for the first time
- **Lithara** representing the Otters at a meet for the first time and achieving three 2nd place and two 3rd place medals
- Daniel achieving a 2nd place in the Boys 14 Over 50m BK
- Liam winning a 3rd place medal for his Boys 13Y 50m FS
- Mingqi representing the Otters at a meet for the first time and winning a 2nd place for his Boys 11Y 50m BK and 3rd place for Boys 11Y 50m FS
- Michaellah placing 3rd in the Girls 14 Over 50m BR
- Keith sweeping all of his Boys 13Y events with 5 gold medals from 5 swims
- Tofy at his first meet in a long time with two 1st place finishes and two 2nd place finishes
- Neno with a 3rd place in the Girls 8 Under 50m FLY
- Rainn with three 1st place medals in the three events he was eligible to swim in
- Raven with a 1st place in the Boys 12Y 50m FLY and three 3rd place finishes in his other events
- Marjy achieving a 2nd in her Girls 14 Over 50m BR and two 3rd placings
- Miguel with a 2nd in the Boys 9Y 50m FLY and BK
- Hannah with a 2nd in her Girls 10Y 50m FS and 3rd in the 100m FS
- Fiona winning a 2nd place for the Girls 11Y 50m BR and 3rd for the FLY
- Vanessa with four 1st place finishes and one 2nd place medal in her Girls 8 Under 50m BR
- Nyakuoth representing the Otters for the first time and winning a 3rd place for her Girls 9 Under 100m FS
- **Kiyara** winning a 2nd place for her Girls 9 Under 100m FS and three 3rd place medals for her FLY, BR and FS 50m events
- Qianyi representing the Otters at a meet for the first time and winning two 3rd place medals
- Gou winning a 3rd place in the Boys 12Y 50m BR
- Kruz winning a 1st, 2nd and 3rd in the Boys 9Y 50m BR, FS and BK, respectively
- Ziao representing the club for the first time at a meet and winning a 2nd in the Boys 8 Under 100m FS and 3rd in the 50m BK
- Zimo with four 1st place medals and one 3rd place for his Boys 9Y 50m BR

This was our first meet since 2019 so a massive thank you to the following people:

With Fiona and Gou being our only Juniors representing in the morning session, along with our State Team (Kelvin, Daniel, Keith, Henry, Jayden, Lucas, Andrew, Scott, William, Bronwyn and Giorgia) in the afternoon, swimmers had their taste of fast-paced racing that highlighted (and in some cases, exposed) their turns and underwater skills.

Special mention to the following swims:-

- Fiona swimming taking on three 200m events (IM, FS & BR) with many learning experiences
- Kelvin swimming 400m FS in a PB, smashing all 16 laps and 15 turns in the process
- Jayden with a great PB in the Men's 13 Over 50m BK and placing 3rd
